## Explanation of any unspent funds (to be provided only if unspent funds remain at the end of the fiscal year):

For Funding Year 2023 Clinton was awarded \$1,250,000.00. In addition, Carryover Funds from the 2022 disbursement totaled \$835,781.50 as follows: 1) The WACH Institute – \$451,891.50; and 2) Additional Combined Areas – \$383,890.00. Therefore, for Funding Year 2023, Clinton has a total of \$1,250,000 (2023 Disbursement) plus \$835,781.50 (Carryover Funds from 2022), which totals \$2,085,781.50. Expenditures for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 total \$1,673,831.12. All remaining funds as of June 30, 2023, will be expended by 12/31/2023.
