Global connections courses engage students in a critical study of the interdependent nature of the global system and the consequences of this interdependence for local and global communities, past and present. The courses in this category will prepare students to move from global awareness to global citizenship, challenging them to consider their responsibility to the common good. Courses will be sorted into two investigative tracks, historical and social scientific, which emphasize varied approaches—quantitative and qualitative analysis, social theory, historical inquiry, analysis of primary and secondary sources, etc.—to historical and contemporary issues. Through these analyses, students will come to understand the contours and complexities of active citizenship on local and global scales.
