The Alternative Pathways to Educator Certiciation (APEC) Program at Coker University provides a pathway for non-certified employees of partnering school districts to become certified classroom teachers. It will deliver certification areaspecific content to APEC participants to support their development as effective teachers in their content area prior to their entering the classroom as the teacher of record. This proposed program will first and foremost help prepare high-quality teachers to close the teacher shortage gap and has the potential to transform the lives of individuals from partnering school districts by helping them acquire their teaching certification, earn a sustainable living wage, and positively impact the lives of generations to come.
