SC EPSCoR has obligated \$420,654.00 to fund 13 GAIN, GAIN CRP, SAN, PHASE-0, and Track II Awards throughout the State. We have also obligated \$51,000 for our newly developed Faculty Research Academy in which we collaborate with the primarily undergraduate institutions, including HBCU's, to train faculty in proposal preparation. We have a remaining \$106,129.03 obligated to manage the affairs of the SC EPSCoR programs and the State Committee. We will roll over the remaining funds for additional programs and support.
