



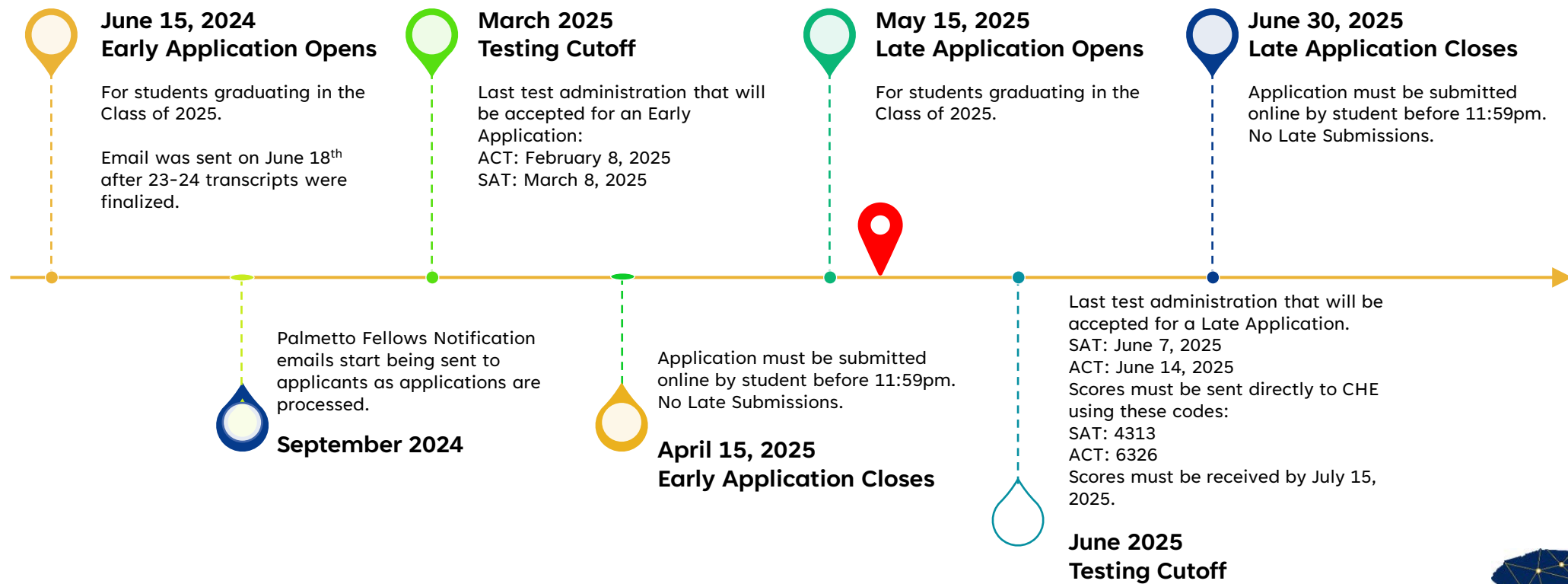

# PFS Year-Round Processing

- Class of 2025 Early Application – Opened 6/18/2024 – Closed on 4/15/2025.
- Class of 2025 Late Application – Opens 5/15/2025 – will close at 11:59pm on 6/30/2025.
- Early Application and Late Applications are two separate apps, cannot be moved from Early to Late. Outstanding Early Apps have been finalized as Ineligible. Students would need to submit a Late App.
- Early Application is ONLY for students who have **ALREADY MET QUALIFICATIONS**. No PENDING applications during the Early Application period.
- CHE will review applications continuously to determine eligibility for the PFS. *\*Late application requires a final 12<sup>th</sup> grade GPA = means transcripts must be finalized before submitting documents.*



# PFS Year-Round Processing

- Decisions will then be uploaded into CHE data system and student email notifications sent. The PFS Portal (for Financial Aid Offices) is real time to the CHE data system, so the students will show in the portal immediately after they are loaded into the CHE data system.
- Estimated processing time from date of application/required materials received at CHE to decision release: **1 month**

- 1) A student cannot apply or earn the PFS once they have graduated high school*
- 2) Mid-year graduates must have application submitted prior to graduating*
- 3) Late award is awarded LATE - usually after tuition bill is due. Please let students and parents know.*



# Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

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For schools that have an official policy on rank that has been reviewed by Commission staff for compliance with the established regulations:

- Rank in the top 6% at the end of the 10<sup>th</sup>, or the 11<sup>th</sup>, or the 12<sup>th</sup> grade academic year; and
- Earn a 1200 SAT/25 ACT; and
- Earn a 3.5 cumulative SC UGP GPA

OR

---

Alternative Criteria (without regard to rank)

- Earn a 1400 SAT/31 ACT; and
- Earn a 4.0 cumulative SC UGP GPA

I understand that if I am notified by the Commission as a conditional candidate, the condition is based on meeting the general eligibility criteria for State scholarships and Grants. I understand that in order to receive the Scholarship: 1) SC residency and US Citizenship/legal permanent residency must be verified by the institution at the time of initial college enrollment and at the beginning of each academic year; and 2) I must attend an eligible SC institution\*. I understand that if I fail to attend an eligible SC institution the fall term IMMEDIATELY upon high school graduation and do not complete the requirements to utilize a Gap Year, and/or do not remain continuously enrolled at an eligible SC institution, or it is determined at any point that I no longer meet SC or US citizenship/legal permanent residency requirements, the Scholarship will be forfeited. If awarded the Scholarship, I also authorize the college that I attend to act as my agent to receive and hold Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Program funds until the funds are applied to my educational expenses. # General State Scholarship & Grant Information



- No State Scholarships or Grants may be used at an out-of-state institution at any time.
- Academic Common Market
  - Allows for South Carolina residents who are enrolled in specific programs at out-of-state institutions to be charged only the applicable in-state tuition by the institution in which the student is enrolled





# TRANSCRIPTS

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In order to determine eligibility for the State scholarship programs, the financial aid office/institution and/or CHE for the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship must have an official transcript on file (electronic or otherwise) that demonstrates the following items:

- A valid signature (electronic or otherwise) from the Principal.\* In the event that the Principal is not available, the Superintendent signature is acceptable.
  - *\*\*For Independent/Private and home school students: The administrator, registrar, or an official from the home school/accountability group. Should provide letter stating designated school rep.*
- SC UGP GPA must be demonstrated
- Date calculated date to be date calculated no later than June 15<sup>th</sup> (regardless of academic year)
  - For the LIFE Scholarship and the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Late Award the transcript MUST demonstrate that it is the final official transcript, as well as reflect a graduation date
- Rank
  - If an independent high school or home school association has an approved policy on rank, a rank must be demonstrated on the official transcript (even if the student is not using rank for scholarship eligibility).
  - A rank report must also be submitted **with a date calculated matching the transcripts** even if the student is not using rank. (LIFE 62-1200.10.C)

# SC UGP GPA

## 62-1200.10. Student Eligibility: LIFE Scholarship and LIFE Scholarship Enhancement

3. (a) Earn a cumulative 3.0 grade point average (GPA) based on the South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy (UGP) upon high school graduation. No other grading policy will be allowed to qualify for the LIFE Scholarship. **Final high school GPAs shall be based on the four-year period of high school attendance, with the exception of Carnegie Units earned prior to high school.** There may be other exceptions, as deemed necessary by the Commission. Grade point averages must be reported to two decimal places (minimum) and may not be rounded. For example, a student who earns a 2.99 GPA is not eligible. Institutions shall use the final GPA as reported on the official transcript. The final official high school transcript must be dated in accordance with the Commission established date(s). If a South Carolina resident student is graduating from an out of state high school, it is the responsibility of the out of state student's school counselor to convert the student's final high school GPA and class ranking to an eligible final high school GPA based on the South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy.

## 62-320. Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Application.

F. Grade point averages must be based on the **current South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy**, reported with at least two decimal places, and may not be rounded up. The South Carolina UGP GPA and class rank (if school/association officially ranks as a policy) must be printed on an official final end of year high school transcript, which must also include a uniform date of calculation as determined by the Commission on Higher Education. The graduation date must also be printed on the final end of senior year high school transcript. No coursework completed after the date of uniform calculation can be included in the end of the year GPA. **Student must meet the scholarship eligibility criteria within four years of high school coursework.**



# Transfer Students

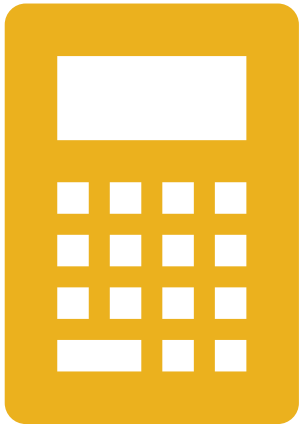
If a student transfers into your school, and they would like to be considered for state scholarships, the new school must provide a cumulative SC UGP GPA either on the new schools' transcript or provide a conversion document that shows the student's cumulative SC UGP GPA.

Class rank uses a cumulative SC UGP GPA, if the student does not have a cumulative SC UGP GPA on their transcript, the student cannot be ranked. The student would be included in the class size and listed on the rank report as not ranked.

If there is no cumulative SC UGP GPA provided, a student will not be eligible for state scholarships.



# Rank & State Scholarship Eligibility



- For the purposes of the LIFE and Palmetto Fellows Scholarship (PFS) programs two students cannot not occupy the same rank.
  - LIFE Scholarship: Top 30% of the graduating class (NOT rounded up to the next whole number)
  - PFS: Top 6% (rounded up to the next whole number)
- In the event of a tie, the high school/home school association is responsible for determining the legitimate rank for each eligible applicant.
  - For the purposes of the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship the student's GPA may need to be truncated past two decimal points in order to determine the true rank for each student.
  - *Inquire about your School District or Board's approved policy*
- Commission staff will NOT be able to participate in the school's process to determine a student's true rank.



# Rank Policies

- In order for a student to use rank from any in-state, out-of-state, public, private, virtual, or charter high school or home school association the process in which rank is determined must be the same for each student.
- A rank policy\* is considered the following:
  - Based on the SC UGP;
  - Ranks ALL academic classes at the END of each academic year (9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>);
  - Includes the entire class. If the entire class is not included when calculating class rank, then rank CANNOT to be considered;
  - Rank and SC UGP must be demonstrated on the official transcript submitted to CHE or eligible SC institution

*\*Please Note: In accordance with 62-1200.10 C (3): Student Eligibility: LIFE Scholarship and LIFE Scholarship Enhancement and 62-320 C (4): Palmetto Fellows Scholarship Application, "High schools or home school associations shall not use ranking for the sole purpose of obtaining eligibility for the state scholarships."*



# Rank Policies

  - Students/parents
  - SC Commission on Higher Education staff
  - SC colleges and universities that award State scholarships

*Please Note: A Rank Report is required to be submitted to Commission staff and/or eligible SC institution by any independent/private high school or homeschool association should a student be using rank as an eligibility criteria for any of the State scholarship programs. (In compliance with Regulation 62-1200.10)*



# Rank Reports

If the school/home school association officially ranks as a policy, a rank report must also be submitted to verify class rank on transcript.

Rank reports must include:

- All diploma-seeking students in the class;
- List their GPAs;
- List their class rank;
- Show “Date Calculated”
  - No later than June 15<sup>th</sup>
- **Information on rank report MUST match information on Transcript.**

### General Eligibility requirements for all programs:

- US Citizen/Legal Permanent Resident\*
- SC Resident\*
- No felony convictions\*\*
- No second or subsequent alcohol/drug misdemeanors
- Not in default on any state or federal loans
- Enroll in a degree-seeking program at an eligible SC institution

\*This must be determined at the time of high school graduation & college enrollment.  
\*\*Excluding Lottery Tuition Assistance.

### QUALIFYING CRITERIA

**SC HOPE**  
\$2,800

- Attend an eligible four-year institution
- 3.0 SC UGP GPA

### CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 3.0 LIFE GPA; and
- Earn an average of 30 credit hours by the end of the first academic year\*

If a SC HOPE recipient satisfies the above criteria, they move into the LIFE scholarship program beginning in their 2nd academic year
