

CLASS RANK FOR SC STATE SCHOLARSHIPS

REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS

In order for a student to use rank from any in-state, out-of-state, public, private, virtual, or charter high school or home school association the process in which rank is determined must be the same for each student.

The rank policy and rank policy information must be available to parents, students, colleges and universities, and the Commission in publication form to include a school's website, student/parent handbook, and/or school profile. The class rank policy must be approved by the SC Commission on Higher Education before students can qualify with class rank.

A rank policy* is considered to be the following:

- ▶ Based on the South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy (SCUGP);
- ▶ Ranks ALL academic classes at the end of each academic year (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th);
- ▶ Rank includes entire class. If the entire class is not included when calculating class rank, then rank cannot be considered;
- ▶ Rank and SC UGP must be demonstrated on the official transcript submitted to CHE or the eligible SC institution
