STARTING POINT

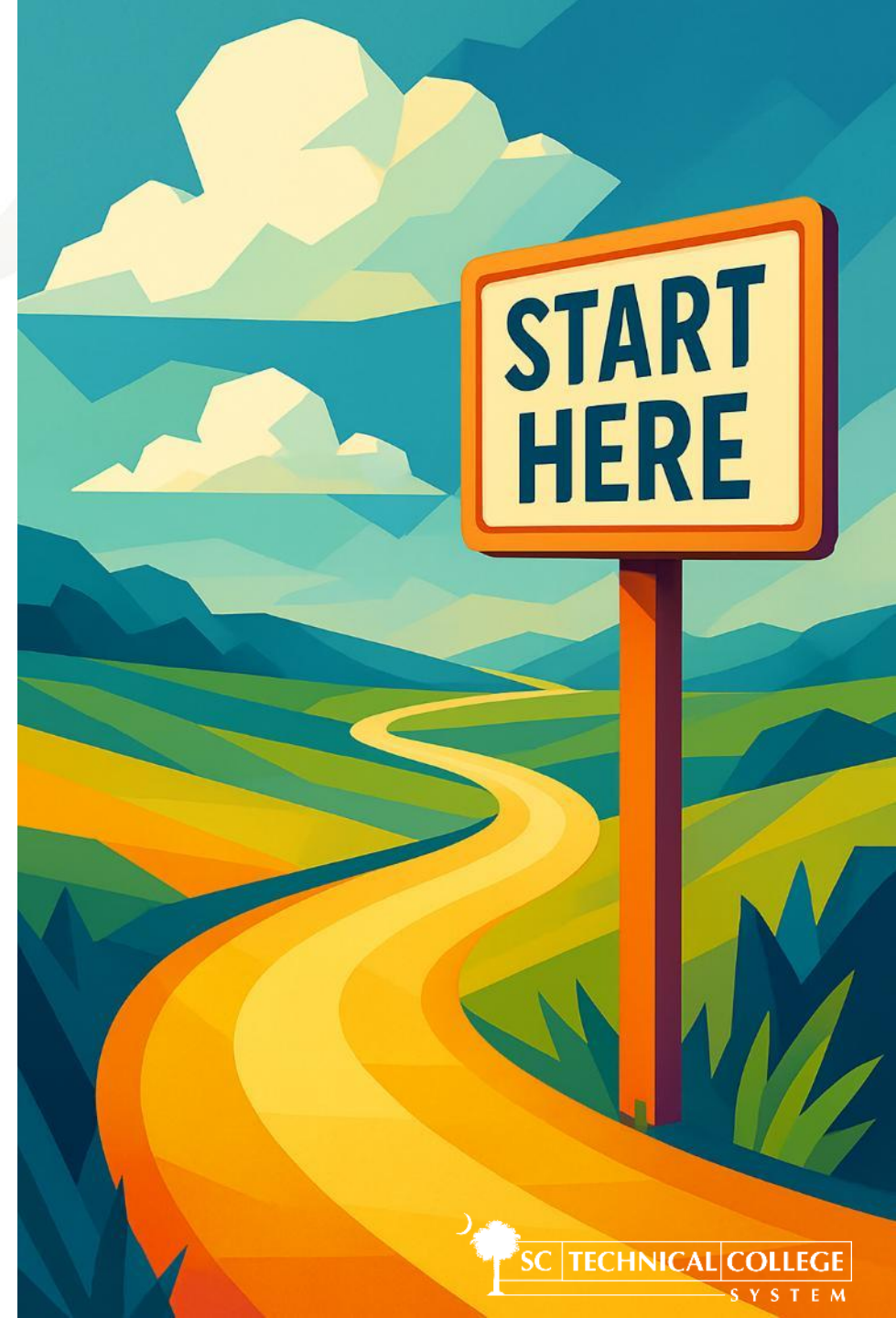
Identify Action Items and Next Steps

All Parties

- Sign on to the National Student Clearinghouse for reverse transfer services
- Explore options to collaborate with Advisors

USC

- Develop specific guides for the top 10 most popular majors for SCTCS transfer students





SECOND STEP

SCTCS joined USC's Transfer Meetings

- Initially, meetings were held monthly; however, after significant progress was made, the schedule shifted to quarterly attendance

THIRD STEP

Data Sharing

- Defined data terminology
- Established annual timeline
- Reviewed reports to understand the landscape





OUTCOMES

- 30+ system-wide programmatic transfer guides published on USC's website
- USC representatives attended 3 SCTCS Peer Group Meetings to give updates on transfer efforts and transfer guides
- Established timeline for data sharing
- SCTCS continues to participate in USC's transfer meetings
