11	TO AMEND THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS BY ADDING SECTION 59-53-35 SO AS
12	TO PROVIDE THE STATE BOARD FOR TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION
13	SHALL ADOPT A POLICY APPLICABLE TO ALL TECHNICAL COLLEGE AREA

22	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina:

24	SECTION 1. Article 1, Chapter 53, Title 59 of the S.C. Code is amended by adding:
25	
26	Section 59-53-35. Before December 1, 2025, the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive
27	Education shall adopt a policy applicable to all technical college area commissions that recognizes and
28	awards credentials and college credit for courses and experiences completed in the military as
29	recommended by the American Council on Education (ACE). Courses and experience completed in
30	the military as recommended by ACE may qualify for exemption credit at the state's technical colleges.
31	The policy must provide that the Joint Service Transcripts or similar service-specific documentation
32	must be reviewed to determine eligibility. Individuals shall coordinate with the local technical college
33	to which they are applying in the eligibility determination process. The Technical College System shall
34	work with the South Carolina Department of Veterans' Affairs to establish guidelines to ensure the
35	consistent review and awarding of eligible credit.
36	
37	SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon approval by the Governor.
