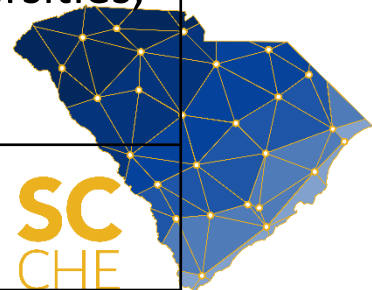

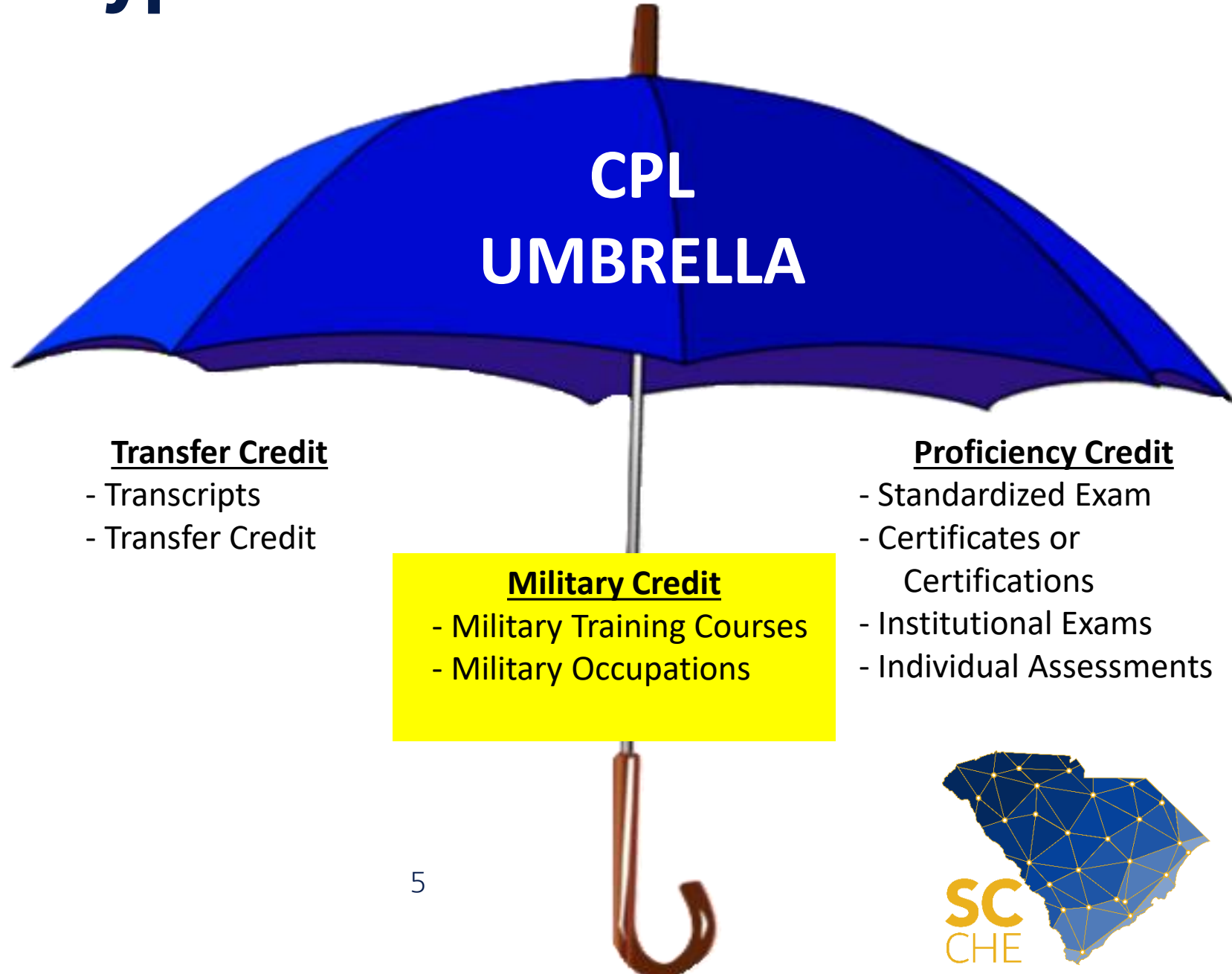

Transfer Mobility of Credits

Keep in mind the following (ATCD):

1. **Admissibility**: Refers to the extent to which military courses and/or military occupations determine a transfer student's admission to a university and, when applicable, admission to a specific program within a university.
2. **Transferability and Degree Applicability-** Refers to the conditions under which a college/university accepts military experience credit courses for inclusion in the student's record.
 - **THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at your military equivalences. Work with colleges to consider more direct subject matter equivalencies**
3. **Course Equivalency and Transferability**: Refers to the process of equating a transfer student's military courses and/or or occupations, both in hours and content, to a university's coursework.
 - **THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at transfer equivalences your institution has already established for military credit within current articulation agreements (if any)**
4. **Degree Applicability**: Applicability of credit toward a degree refers to the prerogative of an academic authority to count specific military experience credit courses toward the fulfillment of a student's degree requirements.
