### **Transfer Mobility of Credits**

Keep in mind the following (ATCD):

 <u>Admissibility</u>: Refers to the extent to which military courses and/or military occupations determine a transfer student's admission to a university and, when applicable, admission to a specific program within a university.

- 2. <u>Transferability and Degree Applicability</u>-. Refers to the conditions under which a college/university accepts military experience credit courses for inclusion in the student's record.
  - THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at your military equivalences. Work with colleges to consider more direct subject matter equivalencies

**3.** <u>Course Equivalency and</u> <u>Transferability</u>: Refers to the process of equating a transfer student's military courses and/or or occupations, both in hours and content, to a university's coursework.

- THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at transfer equivalences your institution has already established for military credit within current articulation agreements (if any)
- **4.** <u>Degree Applicability</u>: Applicability of credit toward a degree refers to the prerogative of an academic authority to count specific military experience credit <sup>®</sup> urses toward the fulfillment of a student's degree requirements.
