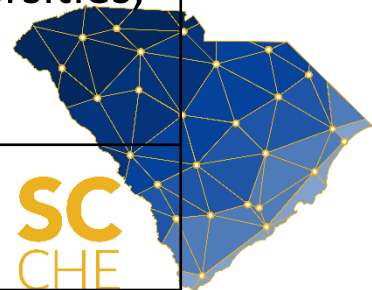

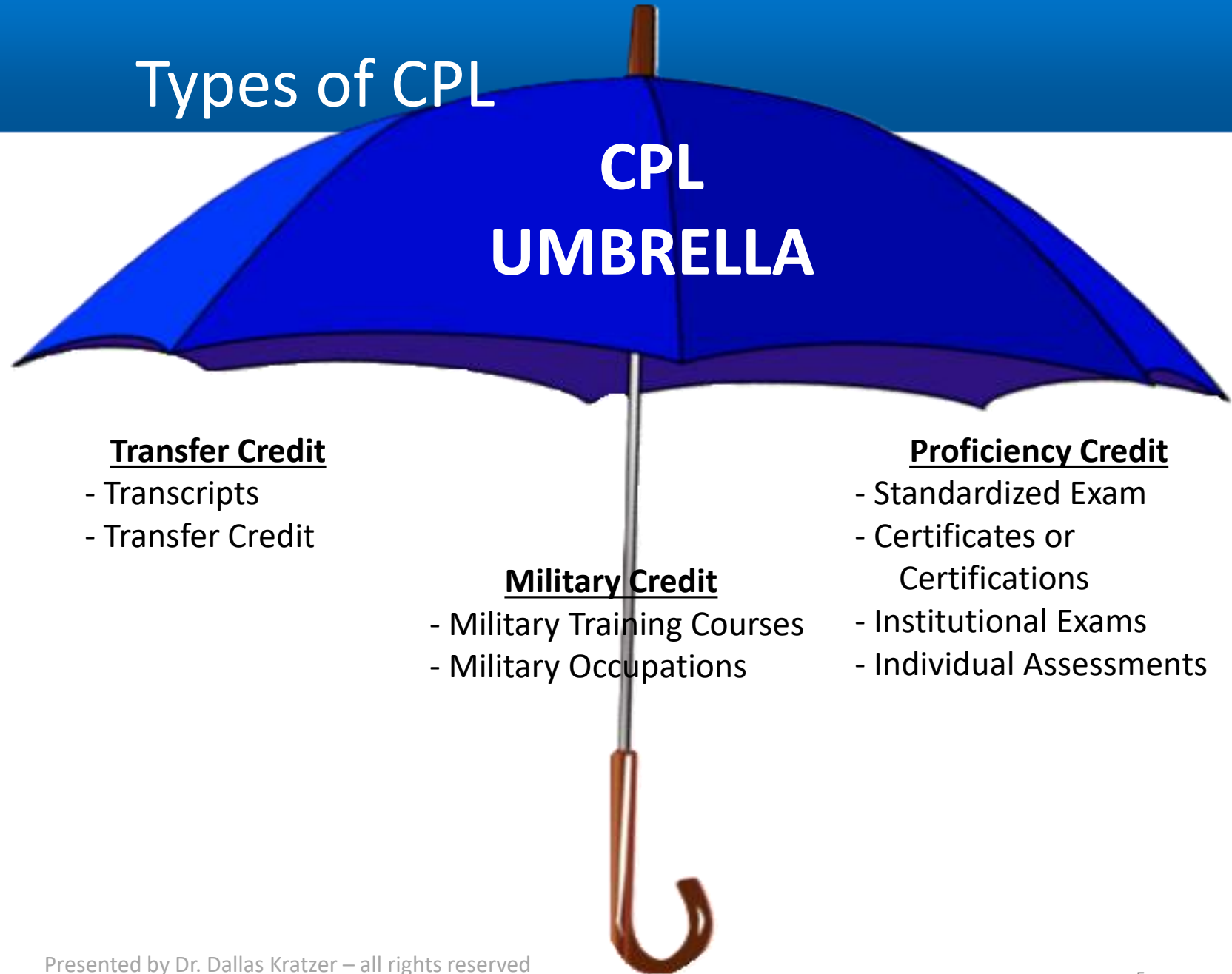

S.C. Military Credit Mobility Taskforce

March 2, 2023:

**Provost charges a task force co-chaired by
Associate Provosts Mark Del Mastro & Chris Korey and including:**

- Executive Director of Career Center
- Executive Director, Continuing & Professional Ed
- Director of Admissions, Veterans/Military/ROTC & Special Populations
- Director of Disability Services
- Associate Registrar for Transfer Evaluation
- Director of Veterans/Military Student Services

Action in 2023:

- Re-assessed our institution's military transfer credit policies.
- Identified and researched 4 possible areas for increasing academic credit for service members:
 - 1) Increase credit hours accepted for Joint Services Transcript (JST): currently 30 credit hours
 - 2) Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) Programs/Portfolio Assessments
 - 3) Articulation agreements with military institutions
 - 4) Expanded credit-by-Exam options

2024:

- **February:**
Concluded that increasing the credit hours accepted for JST from 30 to 66 was the best option to pursue at this time.
- **March 7:**
Formal 4-page proposal to the Committee on Academic Standards, Admissions & Financial Aid (FCAS) to increase from 30 to 66 for credit hours accepted from students' JST and to align with existing proposal that specifies 66 maximum number of transfer hours earned at a 2-year institutions

2024:

- **March 18:**
FCAS meets and approves proposal.
- **April 2:**
Faculty Senate meets to discuss/vote on proposal.
- **August:**
If approved by Senate, new policy goes into effect.

Transfer Mobility of Credits

Keep in mind the following (**ATCD**):

1. **Admⁱssibility**: Refers to the extent to which military experience credit courses determine a transfer student's admission to a university and, when applicable, admission to a specific program within a university.
2. **Transferability and Degree Applicability**-. Refers to the conditions under which a college/university accepts military experience credit courses for inclusion in the student's record.
 - **THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at your military equivalences. Work with colleges to consider more direct subject matter equivalencies**
3. **Course Equivalency and Transferability**: Refers to the process of equating a transfer student's military experience credit courses, both in hours and content, to a university's coursework.
 - **THINGS TO WORK ON: Take a look at transfer equivalences your institution has already established for military credit within current articulation agreements (if any)**
4. **Degree Applicability**: Applicability of credit toward a degree refers to the prerogative of an academic authority to count specific military experience credit courses toward the fulfillment of a student's degree requirements.
