Military Occupation Specialty or Airforce Specialty Code (MOS/AFSC)

- Military Occupation Specialty (MOS/AFSC)
 - Job performed by a service member in the military
- With few exceptions, each service member or veteran has a corresponding Military Occupation Specialty code
 - AFSC, MOS, NEC (example: MOS-36B)
- Focusing on enlisted members

Best Practices – Transfer Mobility of Credits

Keep in mind the following (ATCD):

1. **Admissibility:** Refers to the extent to which military experience credit courses determine a transfer student's admission to a university and, when applicable, admission to a specific program within a university.
2. **Transferability:** Refers to the conditions under which a college/university accepts military experience credit courses for inclusion in the student's record.
3. **Course Equivalency:** Refers to the process of equating a transfer student's military experience credit courses, both in hours and content, to a university's coursework.
4. **Degree Applicability:** Applicability of credit toward a degree refers to the prerogative of an academic authority to count specific military experience credit courses toward the fulfillment of a student's degree requirements.

No public source of military related source data means that each institution creates its own source definition.

Having consistent source definition would be more helpful to potential students.

Advantage:
System is completely flexible and will accept any military related source information provided by the receiving institution. Equivalencies belong to the receiving institutions.

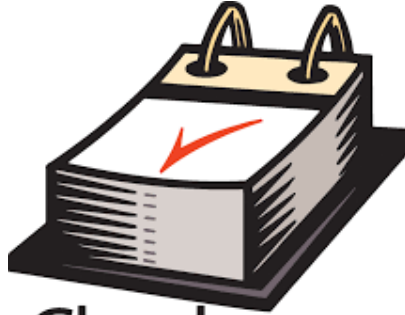
