The South Carolina National Guard College Assistance Program (SCNG CAP) Regulation provides important information regarding the governance of the program by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education (CHE), the SC National Guard, and the higher education institutions <u>SC National Guard College Assistance Program Regulations.</u>

BUDGET UPDATES SCNG CAP 2025-2026 AY:

Per Proviso 117.140. of the FY2025-26 Appropriations (GP: National Guard College Assistance Program) For the current fiscal year, a member of the SC National Guard may qualify for college assistance program grants for more than one hundred thirty semester hours or related quarter hours. Additionally, service members may receive college assistance program benefits up to an amount equal to one hundred percent of college tuition and fees not to exceed twelve thousand dollars for the academic year. The lifetime maximum amount received shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars. Tuition and fees are defined as the amount charged for registering for credit hours of instruction, costs of textbooks, and other fees associated with attendance at an eligible institution. Service members shall be required to meet all other requirements. Service members may complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to receive all eligible federal and state scholarships and grants.

FY 2025-2026 (only) A member of the SC National Guard may qualify for:

- More than one hundred thirty (130) semester hours or related quarter hours.
- Benefits up to an amount equal to one hundred percent of college tuition and fees not to exceed twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) per academic year (maximum \$4,000 per semester for full-time students)
- Fall, spring and summer semesters eligible for aid.
- Lifetime maximum that cannot exceed \$25,000.

Funding amounts are effective for FY2025-26. Amounts are set each year by the SC General Assembly.

OTHER UPDATES SCNG CAP 2025-2026 AY:

Exception to Policy (ETP) – Dual Enrollment

Service members who earned an associate degree, apprenticeship, or certificate <u>during high school</u> (i.e., dual-enrolled students) may be approved by the National Guard to be eligible for CAP funds under an Exception to Policy (ETP) to pursue a second associate degree within five years of receiving the first associate's degree. - ♦ Based upon enrollment, disbursements will typically be paid in three (3) equal disbursements
- ♦ Any remaining funds can be used in any succeeding terms prior to the annual expiration date.
- Per the regulations, the SCNG CAP awards, in combination with all other grants and scholarships, shall not exceed the Cost of Attendance (COA) at the eligible institution in any given award year, and the cumulative total of all College Assistance Program (CAP) benefits received may not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000 lifetime amount.)

I. <u>Eligibility for SC National Guard College Assistance Program (SCNG CAP)</u>

As a reminder, eligible students can receive SCNG CAP funds if they:

- a) are making Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP);
- b) have not exceeded the \$25,000 maximum award amount; and
- c) have not earned a graduate degree. Eligible programs of study are less than one-year certificates or certifications approved by the SC Technical College System, courses completed as the education component of a registered apprenticeship, a certificate or other recognized educational credential (e.g. diploma), the first associate's degree or a second associate's degree earned at a minimum five (5) years after receiving the first associate's degree, a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit towards the first bachelor's degree, and the first bachelor's degree.
- ** Note: Students may receive college assistance benefits upon completion of their first bachelor's degree in a preceding level (less than one-year certificate or certifications, one-year certificate, and two-year program or associate's degree) per Section 62-251 H See SC National Guard College Assistance Program Regulations. As a reminder, service members should not be awarded SCNG CAP funds by word-of-mouth. The <u>Search for National Guard Students</u> link shows the entire list of eligible students for your institution. Press enter and sort the eligibility list by eligibility status – Y/N (use the toggle up/down arrows).

STEP 2

Click the <u>REFRESH STUDENTS</u> button at the top of the page (<u>EVERY TIME</u>) you go to the **Student Update** screen for the <u>current list of students</u>.

- This will cause the system to transfer current eligible student data for the current report period.
- The <u>Refresh</u> Students button <u>will not delete data</u>; it will only bring in additional students not yet on the list and update existing records as needed.
- Once the data is displayed, the Corrected Total Amount, Enrollment Status, Attempted Credit Hours, SAP Progress, and Award Amount fields will be open for each student.

STEP 3

<u>Update the portal and complete the required fields to report</u>/verify enrollment <u>each semester</u> by the designated deadlines (except Summer Awarding Process)- **See Table below on page 6**.

Once the data is entered by the institution, CHE can retrieve the report.
